Some children will begin to learn the different sounds that each letter makes with Fred Frog in Read Write Inc.

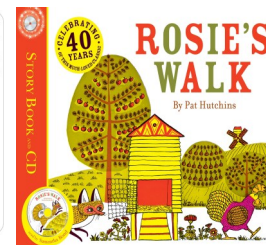
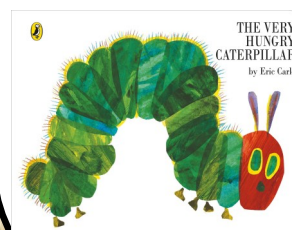
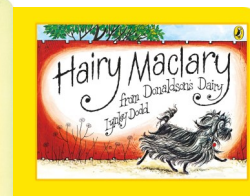
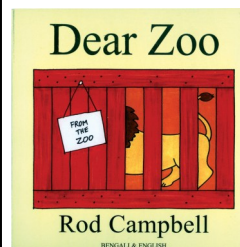
They will also practise forming these letters and begin to hear the sounds that make up words.
