- Please also ensure children's jumpers and coats are named.

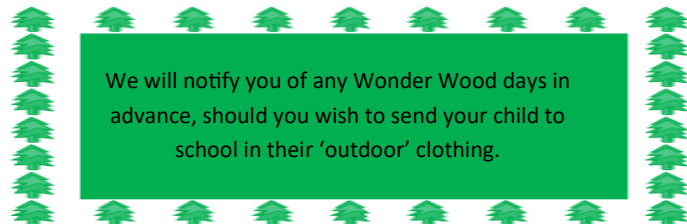
PE Kit Policy:
