### Uniform – Key Reminders

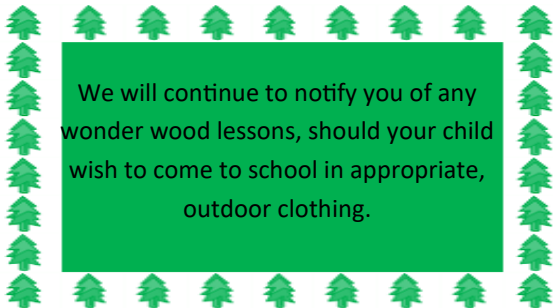
**Key uniform expectations in UKS2 remain the same during the summer term:**
