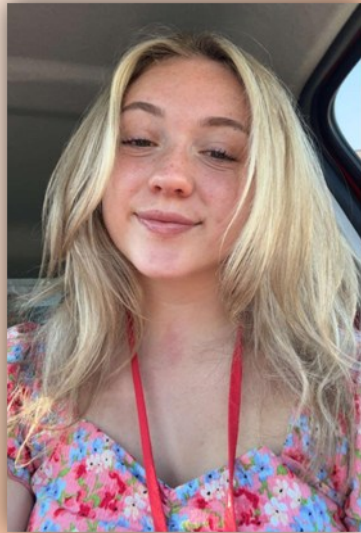

## Nursery Library

Children will bring home a Nursery library book each Thursday. We will help the children choose their book in Nursery. Please share this book with your child and return back to Nursery on their next session after the weekend.

If your child is not at Nursery on a Thursday we will help them to choose a book on an alternate day.

Please ensure your child has a named book bag at Nursery.



Please provide your child with a full set of clothes to change into in case they get wet, dirty, are sick or have a toileting accident.

Please ensure all items are named including clothes, shoes, water bottles, bags, coats and wellies.



## Information about the beginning and end of day:

Nursery is open for drop off at **8:45-8:55am**. Please wait in the playground by the front door and a member of staff will open the door.

Pick up time is between **3:15-3:30pm**. Please be patient as we call the children out to you.

**Ensuring children are safe is our number one priority.**

***Morning sessions ONLY:*** Drop off between 8:45-8:55am

Pick up 11:45am.

***Afternoon sessions ONLY:*** Drop off between 12:30-12:35pm

Pick up 3:15-3:30pm.

A healthy snack is provided every day at Nursery.

This is fresh fruit, vegetables, and milk to drink. Please bring a named water bottle.

They will also need a waterproof and wellies to change into at Nursery.

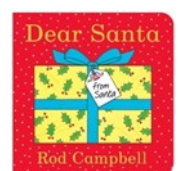
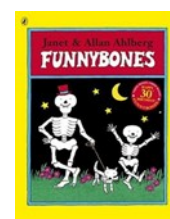
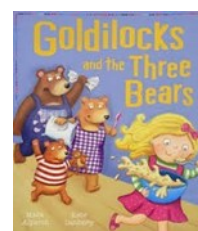
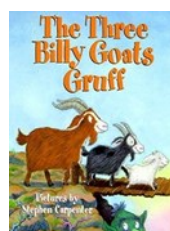
## Themes:

## Talk for Writing

During 'Talk for Writing', children learn a story by listening and retelling the story events to it become familiar to them. This enables them to learn how stories are structured and develop story language throughout the year. Our focus books this term are:
